Writing a CV and application letter in Slovenia

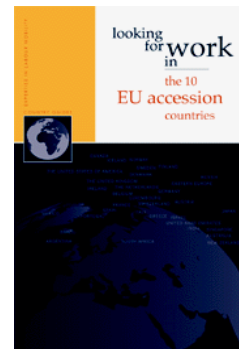
