- The Norwegian CV is usually in reversed chronological order (i.e., most recent first).
- It is common in Norway to send a typed application letter.

The application procedure in Norway

- Be prepared for questions about yourself regarding your strong and weak points.
- Due to obligation for all vacancies to be reported to the Norwegian employment service, it offers great help to look for vacancy there.

Management culture in Norway

- Meetings can take place in an informal atmosphere and jokes are mixed with serious business conversation.
- Office hours in Norway are from 8.30 am till 4.00 pm in summer and 9.00 am–5.30 pm in winter.
